STRATEGIC PLAN (2020-2025)

S.J.K.College, Kalanaur underwent the 2nd cycle of accreditation in 2015. The Executive Committee of the NAAC reaccruited the college on 15-11-2015 at 'B' Grade with CGPA of 2.48 on four point scale. The next cycle of accreditation is due in 2020. To meet the long term vision and mission statements, the institution aims to achieve the following targets by the year 2025:

- **To Introduce New Courses**

The college presently offers UG courses (B.A., B.Com, B.Sc. (Non-Medical), BCA) and PG diploma course (PGDCA). It is proposed that new add-on courses and PG course in Geography and Commerce be introduced in the academic session 2020-2021. Keeping in view the vision of NEP 2020, it is proposed that more courses be started so that the college may gradually move towards becoming multidisciplinary.

- **Increase in the Intake of Students**

Every year, the number of applications for B.A programme exceeds the number seats sanctioned for the course. Keeping in view of the demand, it is proposed that the college will apply for the increase in the intake of students on B.A. programme.

- **Grant-in-aid Status for B.Sc. (Non-Medical)**

At present the B.Sc. Course is running under SFS scheme, it is proposed that the college will apply for grant-in-aid status.

- **To establish Center for Competitive Examinations**

There is lack of coaching institutes for competitive exams in the vicinity. Considering the fact that the students from economically weaker section find it difficult to take up coaching classes, it is proposed that a center for competitive examinations be established and coaching classes be arranged in the college campus.

- **Establish Research Section in the Library**

There is an e-resource access point in the library for the staff as well as the students which needs to be strengthened. To promote research culture, it is proposed that a separate research section be established in the library equipped with more computers/ journals/e-resources etc.

- **Individual Cabins for Teaching Staff**

There were twenty cabins for the staff to facilitate their academic growth which were burnt down during Jat Reservation Agitation in 2015. It is proposed that well-furnished individual cabins for the staff be constructed.

- **Smart Class Rooms**

The College has 3 smart class rooms. To further promote ICT enabled teaching it is proposed that the number of smart class rooms be increased.

- **Upgradation of ICT Enabled Infrastructure**

It is proposed that ICT enabled infrastructure be upgraded and various e-platforms be used for blended teaching-learning.

- **Digitalization**

The college has adopted the practice of maintaining a digital Diary of Events to keep the record of all the events in the college in a systematic manner. To further reduce the paper work and organize the data in the digital format, it is proposed that a Management Information System should be implemented for carrying out various administrative and academic functions.

- **Seminar Hall**

The college has one seminar hall in which seminars and other activities are organized. There is a need of another seminar hall, therefore it is proposed that another seminar hall may be constructed.

- **To Get More MOUs Signed with Organizations/Institutes**

It is proposed that more MOUs be signed with organizations/ institutions.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding [MoU], hereinafter referred to as the Memorandum, entered in this 26th day of April, 2024 between: -

The Airports Authority of India, a body corporate and constituted by the Central Government under the Airports Authority of India Act (Act 55 of 1994) having its Corporate Office at New Delhi, represented by General Manager (HR) - Training GIRIM KUMAR, hereinafter referred to as the "First Party",
AND

Sat Jinda Kalyana (PG) College having its office at Kalanaur (Rohtak) represented by the Principal, Dr. Naresh Kumar Dua, hereinafter referred to as the "Second Party".

WHEREAS, the aforementioned parties desire to enter into the herein described Memorandum through which they shall work together to accomplish the "Aim" of the "Internship Program", as set forth.

[A] AIM:

To create interest in Civil Aviation among students by:

- Supplementing theoretical knowledge with practical operations / working
- Giving exposure to students in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) / non-STEM domains
- Giving opportunity to work on small-duration projects related to Civil Aviation

[B] INTERNSHIP PROGRAM:

Shall refer to the working arrangement between both the parties, as agreed, i.e.:

- i. Being part of project implementation at Airport (Observe implementation & Learn)
- ii. 2-5 days Familiarization (Visits / Workshops)
- iii. 4-20 weeks Internship

[C] APPLICABILITY:

The educational institutions in the vicinity of AAI Airports (25-40 km radius), can sign the MoU for their students undergoing Graduation / Post-Graduation / Professional degree courses.

[D] DURATION OF MoU:

The term of this Memorandum shall be for a period of 5 years from the date of its signing, and may be extended upon written mutual consent by both the Parties on the same terms & conditions or as agreed upon at that point of time.

[E] SCOPE OF COOPERATION:

Through this Memorandum, both the Parties affirm the value of industry-academia collaboration and agree to promote the Internship Program as detailed in Annexure-I.

[F] FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

- i. No stipend or any remuneration would be paid to a participating student or University / College / Institute for any Program.
- ii. Wherever feasible, necessary arrangements of transportation from college to airport and back during workshops / visits may be made by AAI, wherever the number of students is more than 20 and where the Second Party doesn't have its own transport facility.
- iii. Wherever feasible, arrangement of working lunch and provision of literature and books shall be made for students by AAI.

[G] ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES:

The Parties to this MoU have mutually acknowledged and agreed to the following:

- i. To work together in a cooperative and coordinated manner to fulfil the objective of this Memorandum.
- ii. The Second Party shall ensure that students abide by the rules & regulations of AAI, and SOP / instructions as detailed in Annexure-II.
- iii. The Parties to this MoU have the right to individually or mutually terminate their participation in this Memorandum.
- iv. The data / information collected by the students of Second Party would be for sole academic purpose and mutual benefit. No data or information to be shared with third party without the explicit written consent of the First Party.
- v. Any dispute that arises in connection with this MoU shall be settled amicably between the parties. The decision of AAI Management shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- vi. Internship Program is neither an employment opportunity with AAI, nor an aid in securing employment in AAI.
- vii. AAI has absolute unfettered right to restrict the program in any manner, either to institutions or to numbers of participants or in any other manner.
- viii. This MoU does not create any right to students of the institutions or to institutions. This effort of AAI is purely voluntary.

This Memorandum has come into force on the 26th day April month and 2024 year as mentioned above.
